Medication

There is always a safety concern when medication is brought to the school. All medications must be stored at the office and should never be in a child's school bag; the exception to this rule includes Asthma inhalers and epi-pens; these may be in a student's possession if the appropriate consent forms are completed.

Pills such as Tylenol, Advil, etc. must also be brought to the office for proper storage as it is unsafe for students to carry these medications around while at school. Parents/Guardians are asked to please ensure that you personally come to the school office to provide us with any medication that your child may need; at that time you will complete an information/consent to administer form.

Please note: antibiotics that are to be administered three times daily should not be brought to the school; we recommend that you administer this type of prescription just before your child leaves for school, when he/she returns home around 3:30 p.m. and then again at bed time.
